## ESSAY 75: Development of a New System of Education in Science

In the past decade a new system of education in science has been developed based on the websites used to publish and develop the ECE theory. These websites have reached an accurately measured thirty million readers in a decade, and nearly all the universities, institutes and similar in the world. This is a system of free thought which has been developed in Wales with a lot of help from some of best theoretical physicists. It has shaken itself free of the artificial constraints of the university system in Wales, a system which in my experience was run by outsiders and outside ideas. The ECE theory is original thought, not received opinion. I was originally educated within the university system in Wales, but I have developed a thought and education system of my own which has been stunningly successful worldwide. The old system was censorius of new ideas, but censorship of thought never works. I have been much more successful in bringing my ideas to the world than if I were working inside the university system. The latter has a lot of weaknesses as described in essay 64. It consisted of people who were sometimes well meaning and good teachers but who had been appointed without any open competition. I should have been awarded tenure many times over at Aberystwyth and this was openly acknowledged. However tenure was not awarded fairly and ths system was riddled with some terrible animosities, well known in the academic world.. Such a system is in conflict with freedom of thought, and serves Wales so badly that the Nation is in danger of losing its language, culture and very identity.

In great contrast I have always been very successful in the international arena, winning a world record number of open competition fellowships of various kinds. This culminated in the award of a Civil List Pension in 2005. A rarely awarded, national and international high honour partly in recognition of ECE theory. The Pension is granted by the Monarch on recommendation of the First Lord of the Treasury, who is also the Prime Minister, and I was nominated by the Royal Society after international refereeing by distinguished colleagues of the standing of full professor. All were from outside of Great Britain. The list of new pensioners drawn up by the Prime Minister and Monarch is put before Parliament, and very few nominations are successful. A Civil List Pension is a national high honour and life appointment. It can never be decreased or removed, because it is a token of gratitude of the Monarch and Nation for services to science of the highest calibre. None has ever ben removed, and any attempt to suggest the removal of a high honour is a kind of treason. No high honour can be removed on the grounds of difference of opinion. That is a violation of the laws about human rights. It is not very much in monetary terms, certainly not enough to live on, but it is a high national honour. Mine started at 1,400 pounds a year and has been incremented to 2,000 pounds a year. The academic system at Aberystwyth is implicitly criticised heavily by this award for failure to support my scholarship. It still fails to support my scholarship. The academic system has read my work by the tens of millions over a decade, so there is nothing wrong with my work, and it is accepted academically by almost everyone. There was and is a lot wrong with the colonial attitudes of the University of Wales, which has recently disintegrated into heavily criticised corruption.

In 2008 I was awarded my coat of arms in recognition of services to both science and the community and was raised to the gentry or untitled nobility in Wales by the College of

Arms in London. Again, Aberystwyth failed to recognise this further honour. In the past I have been told mindless things at Aberystwyth, that I would never get a job there because I was too truthful. So it is a ghastly failure in many ways. Only the most boorish of fools would say that a scholar can be too truthful. The ECE theory has made such a massive impact because of the astounding revolution in knowledge and communication brought about in the past decade by the internet, websites and open access publishing. The "official" physics is dead in the water, none of its ideas remain intact. Papers such as UFT225 reveal astounding errors in its basics, and the official physics covers these up to absolutely no purpose. Finally this year I was included in "Burke's Peerage and Gentry". I like to think that this is on merit, not because of my descent from the Princes of Wales. This descent was discovered only recently, with meticulous genealogical research. All of us in Wales are probably related if we go back far enough, and all descended from the Princes.

The ECE theory is a societal phenomenon the likes of which have never been seen before, it is heavy theoretical physics yet read by tens of millions. I think that its success is based on meticulous scholarship the likes of which are rarely found at university. The truth is university staff past post doctoral spend their time in committees. It takes continuous dedicated long hours of meticulous scholarship to make real advances in physics. A Civil List pensioner has no duties and need not do anything at all, but in my case I have produced my best work since earning the pension. I have also found the best way of teaching. University teaching is not nearly so effective.

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
